

### Guidelines for Abstract Submission

The following are the guidelines for the author to prepare the Abstract for the conference. Please read them carefully and follow the instructions.

#### File Naming Convention and Paper Code

You are required to use a paper code when naming your paper. You should also type this code in the Header at the top left side of the paper. The paper code is as follows:

PaperType\_Subject\_ConferenceStrandNumber\_InitialsOfPresenterName

#### F\_S\_2\_JGA

- A. Paper Type is categorised as:
- Abstract only and won't submit full paper (**A**)
  - Full Paper (**F**)
  - Poster Presentation (**P**)
  - Workshop (**W**)
  - Symposium (**S**)
- B. Subject is either **S** (for Science) and **M** (for Mathematics).
- C. Conference Strand Number should be any number ranging from 1 to 5 referring to the five strands of the conference theme. You must choose only one number that best describes your paper.

- D. Initials Of Presenter Name refers to the first letters of each of your name. For example, **John Glenn Augustine** would be coded **JGA**.

#### Important Notice:

- The author has agreed to the terms and agreement that all abstracts and papers submitted have not been sent to any other publication. The author will be required to compile the copyrights transfer agreement.
- Selected quality full papers will be recommended for publication. Publication fee will be paid by the author to a SCOPUS or ISI Journal after the conference.
- Selected quality full paper will be evaluated by a Paper Review Committee under Chief Paper Editor to select for Best Paper Award.

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**Abstract** (*12 point, single spacing*)

Please also note that if you are the paper presenter but not the first author, place an asterisk before your name. The abstract should be about 250 words in one paragraph. It should state briefly the purpose of the research, the main results and major conclusions. Use single line spacing. The font size should be Times New Roman, 12 points italic.*
