INTRODUCTION

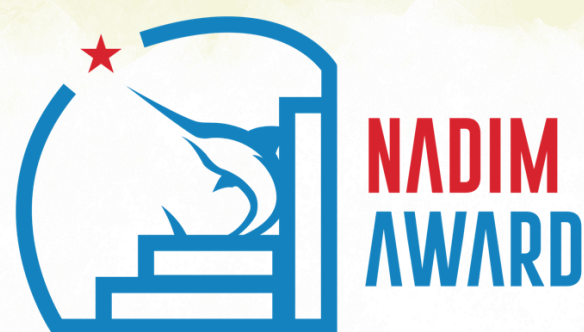
